Local Arrangements Guide NECMT 2019

Schulich School of Music • McGill University
Montreal, Quebec, Canada • April 13–14

Conference site: The NECMT 2019 program will take place in [Tanna Schulich Hall](#), in McGill University's Schulich School of Music in downtown Montreal, Quebec. For NECMT members travelling from New England, Montreal is a five-hour drive from Boston or from Portland, Maine; six hours from New Haven; four hours from Concord, NH; or 1 hour, 45 minutes from Burlington, VT.

The conference address is 527 Sherbrooke West, and entrance is at street-level.

Lodging and dining: The most convenient and affordable hotel for the conference is [L'Appartement-Hotel](#) at 455 Sherbrooke West, just steps away from the McGill music building; other hotels within easy walking distance are the Delta ("[Delta Hotels by Marriott Montreal](#)") and the Hilton ("[Hilton Garden Inn Montreal Centre-Ville](#)"). There are over 30 hotels within a 10-minute walk of the location and compared to many cities of similar size, Montreal is a surprisingly affordable city to visit. You will also find many [restaurants nearby](#), and for those more adventurous visitors Montreal's unsurpassed dining scene is easily accessed using [the metro](#) (Montreal's subway system). There is a station entrance just 50m away from the music building.

McGill University and Montreal: The Schulich School of Music is at the edge of McGill's attractive downtown campus, which sits at the foot of Montreal's iconic Mount Royal. Visitors can enjoy a walk on the slopes of this "mountain", whose summit and the excellent views of the surroundings are easily accessible via a set of staircases. If you are interested, the path starts at the top of rue Peel, just a few blocks west of the music building.

There will be an opportunity for tours of McGill's music facilities during the conference weekend.
